Monthly income: approximately ₹10,000

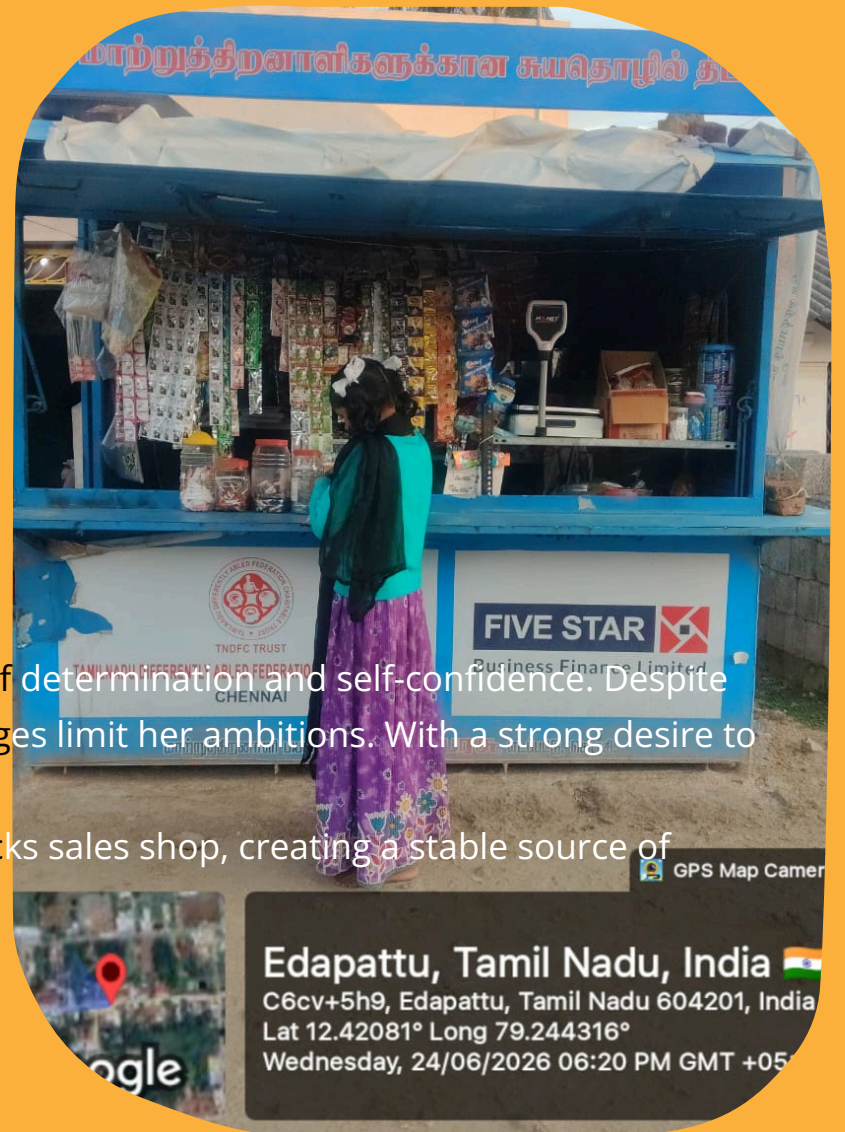
This regular income helps her meet her family's daily needs and has significantly improved her economic condition. She now leads a life of dignity and independence without depending on others.
