Mrs. Anburose A, a resident of Kolancheri, Tiruvallur District, runs a small clothing shop (Thuni Kadai) with the support of her husband, Mr. Arulraj. With the objective of improving her family's economic condition, she started this business with minimal investment.

Initially modest, her clothing shop has steadily grown and now generates a daily turnover of ₹500 to ₹700, resulting in a monthly income of approximately ₹15,000. This income significantly supports her family's daily expenses and helps her lead a self-reliant and dignified life.

At the age of 46, Mrs. Anburose A, despite having 65% disability, continues to run her business with strong determination, hard work, and confidence. By offering quality clothing at reasonable prices and maintaining good relationships with customers, she has earned a good reputation in her local community.

Mr. Rajendran R, son of Mr. Rajalingam, is a resident of Sengurichi (Sungasavadi), Ulundurpettai Taluk, Kallakurichi District. With the aim of improving his family's economic condition, he is engaged in fruit selling as a self-employment activity.

🍌 Fruit Business Details:

### Guava

Daily purchase quantity: approximately 80 kg

Purchase amount: ₹3,200 per day

Daily sales income: around ₹1,500

### Jackfruit

Purchase quantity: 50 pieces per lot

Purchase amount: ₹5,000

Sold completely within 2 to 3 days

Monthly income: approximately ₹12,000

Mr. Rajendran R, aged 47, despite having 65% disability, runs his fruit business with strong determination, continuous effort, and self-confidence. By supplying fresh and good-quality fruits at reasonable prices, he has earned the trust and goodwill of customers in his locality.

The income generated through this fruit business helps him meet his family's daily needs and supports him in leading a self-reliant and dignified life.
