DIGITAL SAKTHAM – A PROJECT FOR ESTABLISHING 16 E-SEVA CENTRE'S FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES



Through the Digital Saktham Project, 16 e-Seva Centres have been successfully established across Tamil Nadu with the objective of ensuring economic self-reliance for persons with disabilities. Under this initiative, 16 selected beneficiaries with disabilities have become micro-entrepreneurs, delivering essential government and digital services in their local communities.

A one-time investment of ₹16,87,500/- was made for the successful implementation of this project. This investment has enabled sustainable livelihoods, enhanced social dignity, and created entrepreneurial opportunities for persons with disabilities.
